Subject:- Delegation of powers to sanction and disburse the various relief measures to the victims of November, 1984 riots/terrorists violence.

Sir,


I am directed to address you on the subject noted above and to state that, henceforth, the powers, to sanction and disburse the relief grants in following cases shall be exercised by the Sub-Divisional Officers (Civil), concerned:-

- i) Payment of ex-gratia grant to the next of kin of innocent civilians killed by terrorists/by security forces acting in aid of civil power, in the State.
- ii) Lump sum cash relief to innocent civilians, who suffered 100 % disability on account of the injuries sustained at the hands of terrorists/by security forces acting in aid of civil power, in the State.
- iii) Relief to injured persons.
- iv) Marriage grant on the occasion of marriage of each daughter/sister of person killed by terrorists or by security forces acting in aid of civil power/ November, 1984 riots.
- v) Compensation for Movable and Immovable property including damage to buildings, loss of merchandise, loss of household goods and for loss/damage to private vehicles, by terrorists/by security forces acting in aid of civil power, in the state.
- vi) Payment of Ex-gratia grant, transport allowance and rental allowance to the internal and external

vii) Sanctioning and disbursement/ subsistence allowance of to the widows of November, 1984, riots/terrorists victims

2. The Sub Divisional Officers(Civil) concerned shall be personally responsible for the disbursement of aforementioned reliefs to the affected persons. The Government feels that it should be the administration which should go to the affected families rather than the members of the affected families come to the Government offices for getting their ex- gratia payment and other relief admissible to them.
3. It is also clarified that relief in all cases should be disbursed within 10 days by the respective Sub Divisional Officers. In all such cases of delay beyond 10 days S.D.O(C) should send a statement to the Deputy Commissioner giving reasons for that.
4. The Sub Divisional Officers (Civil) shall place their demands of funds for this purpose with their respective Deputy Commissioners, who will intimate their requirement to the Director, Relief and Resettlement Department, Punjab, Chandigarh. On the receipt of demand of funds from the Deputy Commissioners, the Director Relief and Resettlement shall place the required funds with the Deputy Commissioners, who shall further allocate the same to the respective S.D.Os(Civil) in the District according to their requirements.
5. The monitoring of progress in respect of the various Relief and Resettlement measures and utilisation of funds shall, however, be continue to be done by the Deputy Commissioners, as before.
