Subject :- Grant of financial assistance to the families of the CRPF, BSF, Home Guards, Civil Defence Official, / Special Police Officers who die while on active duty

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference on the subject noted above and to say that in partial modification of Punjab Government instructions issued vide Punjab Government letter No. 14/6/84/3H(I)/& 25/33/84-200/3398, dated 13th February, 1985 and Punjab Memo No. 6010-2H(I)-88/38666, dated 28th/31st October, 1988 and Memo No. 5/7/88-2H(I)/16801, dated 15-5-89, Government have decided to grant of special ex-gratia grant to the families of Government employees who while performing the duties, dies as result of attack by or during action against extremists, at the following rates w.e.f. 1-7-90 and upto the date of State or any part of it, continues to be disturbed area :-

<u>Sr.No.</u>	<u>Category</u>	<u>Amount</u>
1.	Non-Gazetted Police Personnel, CRPF, BSF and Civil Defence Officials including special Police officers and Home Guards, Volunteers.	Rs. two lacs.

2. Gazetted Police/Home Guards Personnel. Forty months pay (as defined under Rule 2.44 of CSR Vol. I, Part I subject to minimum of Rs. two lacs.

subject to the condition that special ex-gratia grant will be inclusive of the amount admissible to these categories under Rule 2.7 of the Punjab Civil Services Volume II.

2. Government also observes that while conveying the above sanction, the existing categories of employees who are eligible for grant of Ex-gratia grant, has been kept in view and no change has been made in these categories.

3. This issues with the concurrence of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms vide their I.D. No. 18/112/89-2P1 33099 dated 12th November, 1990.
