
Sub: Disbursement of ex-gratia etc. under the 'Rehabilitation Package' to the victims of 1984 riots residing in Chandigarh.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. 1/2/2005-I DM-III/3016 dated 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2006 on the subject noted above and to say that most of the victims of 1984 riots, who are presently residing in Chandigarh, had originally settled in various parts of Punjab after migrating from other States. They subsequently shifted to Chandigarh and are presently living there. These riot victims are understood to have been issued red cards by the respective Deputy Commissioners and the records relating to them are available with local administration of the Government of Punjab. It would, therefore, be easier for the Government of Punjab to verify their claims. It would be difficult for the UT Administration of Chandigarh to do so as they would not be having any records on the basis of which their claims could be verified.

2. In view of the above, it has been decided that the riot victims of 1984, who are living in Chandigarh, may be paid rehabilitation grant and other assistance admissible to them under the Rehabilitation Package sanctioned vide Ministry of Home Affairs letter No. U. 13018/46/2005-Delhi I (NC) dated 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2006. You are requested to kindly take necessary action accordingly under intimation to this Ministry.
