Subject:- Grant of subsistence allowance to the widows/dependents of those killed in terrorist violence/November, 1984 riots.

Attention is invited to Punjab Government Notification


No:8/259/90-RR-II/10778 dated 10-5-90, wherein under clause (vi) of Sub-Rule (i) and (ii) of Rule 3, it has been laid down that the Orphans rendered as such, due to terrorists activities/action by Security forces acting in aid of civil power, are eligible for the grant of Subsistence allowance at the rate of Rs. 1000/- per month, with effect from 1-5-90.

2. Now, doubts have been expressed as to who should apply on behalf of the minor orphan, and in what application form, for the grant of subsistence allowance for him. The matter has been examined at length and it has been found that there are already adequate legal provisions under Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 and the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 regulating the appointment of a Guardian of a minor orphan and the application of the relevant provisions of law as contained in the aforesaid two Acts is sufficient to cover the type of cases under discussion.

3. The Sub-Divisional Officers (Civil) are requested to process and sanction the cases of subsistence allowance pertaining to the minor orphans of the parents killed by terrorists/security forces acting in aid of civil power/ Nov ,1984, riots in accordance with the above provisions of Law.

4. The above instructions may kindly be brought to the notice


