Subject:-

Implementation of the recommendation of Justice Nanavati Commission of Inquiry into 1984 riots regarding uniformity in compensation and Relief/Rehabilitation- review of policy regarding riots affected and terrorists affected families.

The Council of Ministers in its meeting held on 18.2.2006 has taken following decisions on the subject cited above.

- (1) Existing policy of 5% reservations of plots/houses by Urban Estates/Improvement Trust/PEPSU Township Development Board etc. for these families shall continue for five years more (i.e. up to the end of year 2011), but without any financial concession in rates. In cases where such allotments are being made by open auction, limited auction for these categories to the above extent may be adhered to.
- (2) The facility of compassionate employment to one dependent of the person killed or 100% disabled shall continue.
- (3) Subsistence allowance/pension ( present rate of Rs.2500 per month) shall continue to be paid to widows, parents and orphan children. The categories of all parents of persons killed and wives of disabled ( more than 70%) persons/missing persons mentioned by the Government of India in their latest decision dated 16.1.1006 may be included in it. The condition regarding income limit of Rs.5000 p.m.( including the amount of subsistence allowance) is deleted. Orphaned children shall be allowed this financial help up to the time the youngest orphan child in a family crosses the age of 25 years.
- (4) The Dependent daughters/sisters of person killed will continue to be given a grant for marriage at uniform rate of Rs. 25,000 (At present the rate in case of riot victims is Rs.10,000, whereas it is Rs. 25000 in terrorists affected cases).
- (5) Facility of free education up to final (MA/ M.Sc. etc.) completion in general education in Government/Government aided institutions/Universities; payment of stipend to School/college going children; and reservation of seats in admission of professional/technical/medical institution will continue.

2. In addition, the other facilities intimated from time to time shall continue heretofore .

A copy is forwarded to the Principal Secretary Local Govt., Principal Secretary Education (School), Principal Secretary Finance, Secretary Medical Education, Secretary, Technical Education, Punjab, Secretary Housing and Urban Development, Secretary Higher Education, Secretary Personnel, for information and necessary action.
