Subject:- Grant of relief to the terrorist affected families-ex-gratia to the School/College going children.

Reference this department Memo No.12/102/94-RR-II/13547, dated 21-7-1994, on the subject noted above.

2. The State Government of Punjab have already decided to pay ex-gratia/scholarships to the school and college going children of the deceased innocent civilians (Private citizens) at the rate of Rs.300/- and Rs.500/- per month with effect from 1-4-1994. But this relief was not extended to the wards who have been studying in the medical, professional and technical schools and colleges/institutions. Subsequently on reconsideration of matter, it has been decided to make payments of ex-gratia/scholarships at the rate of Rs.500/- per month to the wards of terrorists victims who have joined any course/discipline, such as medical/technical/professional courses after 10+2 considering them to be college level. Other children of terrorists victims, who are studying in any discipline like I.T.I., nursing etc. without passing 10+2 Class are entitled to get Rs.300/- per month.

3. These scales of ex-gratia/scholarship shall be paid with effect from 1-4-1994, which is the actual date of this scheme.

4. The beneficiaries may be asked to apply for the ex-gratia to concerned Sub-Divisional Officers(C) with a certificate from the Head of the college/institution where they are studying, stating therein the relevant information about the name, parentage, complete address and details of discipline of the student in which he/she may be studying. The Sub-Divisional Officer(C) concerned shall carefully verify the facts from the institution/college authorities before making the payment of ex-gratia to the eligible student. The particulars of beneficiaries may also be verified from the original case file of deceased/Red Card, issued to the widow or next of kin as the case may be. The payments shall be made to the student through their mother/guardian.

5. The student who repeat a year in a class/discipline shall not be eligible for this concession for that year.

6. The expenditure involved will be debitable to the head "2235-Social Security and Welfare-60-Social Security and Welfare Programme-110-Other Insurance Scheme-09-Relief to persons affected by riots-53-Compensation to person effected by riots."

7. If any doubt arises to the interpretation of any provision of these instructions, the matter may be referred to the Director Relief & Resettlement Punjab for advice.

8. This issues with the concurrence of Department of Finance conveyed vide their I.D. No.8/9/94-3FEVI/1353, dated the 7th May,1996.


