Subject :- Free bus travel on Punjab Government buses for the terrorist's victim widows.

Principal Secretary to Government Punjab,
Department of Transport may kindly refer to the subject noted above.

2. Under the 'Action Plan', the State Government of Punjab has decided to extend the facility of free travel in the buses of Punjab Roadways as well as Pepsu Roadways Transport Corporation, within the territory of Punjab, in ordinary buses only, for nearly 6000 terrorist's victim widows with effect from 1.1.1997. The free travel concession is also to be extended to an assistant of the old, infirm and weak widows of terrorists' violence victim who are not in a position to travel independently. This scheme has been approved in principle, and the amount for the expenditure on this scheme, will be re-imbursed by the Department of Relief and Resettlement to the State Transport Department, on actual basis, after the expiry of every quarter of the year. Department of Relief and Resettlement, as well as the State Transport Department will jointly evolve a suitable scheme in due course, after working out the various details and will seek approval of the same from the Chief Minister, Punjab through the Minister-in-charge of the Transport Department.

He is therefore requested to direct the State Transport Department to implement this scheme with effect from 1-1-1997, pending evolution of a suitable scheme, on the pattern of the similar concession being given to the Freedom Fighters and their spouses, at the moment.
